

STATUS OF CLEANUP ACTIVITIES:

Hazardous Site Response Act cleanup levels have been met for source materials and soil. Identified responsible parties are unable or unwilling to conduct the required investigation and/or cleanup under the Hazardous Site Response Act for groundwater. EPD may perform these actions using state funding from the Hazardous Waste Trust Fund and may lien the property or pursue cost recovery.

REGULATED SUBSTANCES RELEASED, AND THREATS TO HUMAN HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT POSED BY THE RELEASE:

This site has a known release of Pentachlorophenol in groundwater at levels exceeding the reportable quantity. No human exposure via drinking water is suspected from this release. The nearest drinking water well is between 0.5 and 1 miles from the area affected by the release.

This site has a known release of Arsenic in soil at levels exceeding the reportable quantity. This site has unlimited access. The nearest resident individual is less than 300 feet from the area affected by the release.
