

STATUS OF CLEANUP ACTIVITIES:

Hazardous Site Response Act cleanup levels have been met for source materials. Identified responsible parties are unable or unwilling to conduct the required investigation and/or cleanup under the Hazardous Site Response Act for soil and groundwater. EPD may perform these actions using state funding from the Hazardous Waste Trust Fund and may lien the property or pursue cost recovery.

This site has a release of Benzo(a)anthracene that exceeds a reportable quantity because it has the potential to contaminate groundwater. The nearest drinking water well is less than 0.5 miles from the area affected by the release.

This site has a known release of Benzo(a)anthracene in soil at levels exceeding the reportable quantity. This site has unlimited access. The nearest resident individual is between 301 and 1000 feet from the area affected by the release.
