

STATUS OF CLEANUP ACTIVITIES:

Hazardous Site Response Act cleanup levels have been met for source materials and soil. Although directed to by EPD, identified responsible parties are not currently performing the required investigation and/or cleanup under the Hazardous Site Response Act for groundwater. Enforcement is pending.

CLEANUP PRIORITY: The Director has designated this site as a Class I

GA EPD DIRECTOR'S DETERMINATION REGARDING CORRECTIVE ACTION:

The Director has determined that this site requires corrective action.

REGULATED SUBSTANCES RELEASED, AND THREATS TO HUMAN HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT POSED BY THE RELEASE:

This site has a known release of Vinyl chloride in groundwater at levels exceeding the reportable quantity. No human exposure via drinking water is suspected from this release. The nearest drinking water well is between 0.5 and 1 miles from the area affected by the release.

This site has a known release of Tetrachloroethene in soil at levels exceeding the reportable quantity. This site has unlimited access. The nearest resident individual is between 301 and 1000 feet from the area affected by the release.
