INSTRUCTIONS FOR TAKING LEAD THIRD-PARTY EXAMS FOR GEORGIA CERTIFICATIONS

Lead Inspector, Lead Risk Assessor, and Lead Supervisor Exams

To meet the requirements for Georgia certification in these three disciplines, you must take and pass a third-party national lead exam and submit your documentation with us to verify that it is acceptable. Our Duty Officer's telephone number is (404) 363-7026.

The third party exams are given at multiple test centers in every state. You do not have to take the exam in Georgia. To locate a test center and schedule the exam do the following:

Go to www.pearsonvue.com/leha on the Internet.

When the Internet page appears, go the right side of the page and click "**Locate A Test Center.**" Fill out the required information and choose a test location by highlighting your choice to obtain a map and directions to the center. After choosing the test center, click "**Test Taker Services**" located on a tab near the top of the Internet page.

On the left side of the page under "**Select Your Category,**" click on "**Construction Trades UST & Inspections.**" On the right side of the same page, click on "**Lead and Environmental Hazard Association (LEHA).**" Located at the bottom of this same page, choose either "**Schedule Online**" and create an account or "**Schedule By Phone**" and finalize scheduling via phone.
