Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. 12-7-1 et seq.

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7.05 (2)(a-k)}: a. f

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

Application proposes to impact 425 linear feet (4,970 square feet) of stream buffer to three open waters (tributaries of Gum Branch Creek) for widening and improvements to Colerain Rd, including the addition of a sidewalk and a multi-use trail. Disturbance activities will consist of cut and fill, installation of silt fence, construction access, and clearing associated with widening, the re-construction of a dirt access road, and the construction of the multi-use trail. Project on Colerain Rd begins 2,664 feet west of I-95 and ends 1,500 feet east of Kings Bay Rd in Camden County.
