Type of PermitApplication: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. 12-7-1 et seq.

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7-.11 (2)(a-k)}: (h)

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

The project involves buffer encroachments necessary to construct a mixed-use re-development to include a senior living facility, a storage facility, a restaurant, retail shops, trails and parks as well as associated parking and access roads. Stormwater management facilities will also be incorporated into the site. The 9.22-acre project site is located near the intersection of Church Street and Milscott Drive in DeKalb County. The proposed development will require permanent impacts (pipe/fill) to 171 linear feet of buffer along an unnamed tributary to Peachtree Creek South Fork.

The application for a variance must include an approved Erosion and Sediment Control Plan with control measures based on sound conservation and engineering practices which meet or exceed the standards in the "Manual for Erosion and Sediment Control in Georgia" and which will minimize erosion and deposition of sediments on adjacent lands or into State waters.
