Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

Applicant proposes to impact a total of 169 linear feet (20,505 ft²) of stream buffer along an unnamed tributary to Starr Creek to breach two earthen dams that are in disrepair and have failing outlet control structures. Once the dam breached and the streams are returned to a natural pattern, plan and profile, the area will be stabilized and re-vegetated. The 116-acre property is proposed to be a two-phased single-family residential subdivision located at 2980 Hurt Bridge Rd. in unincorporated Forsyth County.
