

Mr. Capp,

I am very concerned about the emissions from the proposed Pyramax plant in Wrens. The levels of particulate matter stated in its application will be enough to change the quality of life in the area around the plant. The amount of hazardous liquids the plant would be using for operations will almost ensure contamination of nearby creeks from run off from its facility. My family's farm is just a few miles down from the proposed site and it would greatly affect the lakes on the property. The amount of ground water plant would consume would lower the already low water table and affect the amount of drinking water available in the area. The quality of ground water could very well be affected. Increased truck traffic, lowered property values, and general health would certainly affect the quality of life in the area. I ADDAMANTLY OPPOSE this project.
