



As noted in a recent news article (*Macon Telegraph*, Feb. 2, 2009), your division will begin holding hearings in March 2009 regarding the construction of Plant Washington.

The permitting of this plant affects more than the people and resources within Washington County. Georgia's skies, especially those over Metro Atlanta, are already poisoned with the type of pollutants this plant will produce. The global warming crisis is becoming more acute with every passing day, caused by the carbon dioxide this plant will produce. This plant would be one of the first built under the whole new standards that govern the emission of CO<sub>2</sub>, given the Supreme Court's ruling on the issue. The new Obama Administration is prepared to deal with global warming and pollution as the crises that they are, which is almost certain to include some form of additional taxes and costs imposed on CO<sub>2</sub> emitters. Dynegy Corporation just last month pulled out of its partnership with LS Power to build new coal-fired power plants throughout the country, including one in Early County. Dynegy CEO Williamson explicitly stated that it is not economically feasible to build new coal plants in the current economic and environmental climate. Other companies in other states have dropped plans to build new coal plants, most recently in Nevada.

Georgians desperately need a full airing of how the proposed construction of Plant Washington fits in with the radically new economic, financial, and environmental circumstances governing coal-fired power plants. I am a customer of Cobb Energy, and I and other members have gotten nothing but stonewalling from Cobb EMC in response to our requests for information on how the decision to build Plant Washington was reached.

You are a steward of the public's interest. I know you will meet your obligation to see to it that all facets of this proposal get a full public airing. Therefore, I am requesting that EPD hold additional hearings in the following places: Atlanta or Cobb County, Augusta, and Macon. In order to ensure full public participation, I ask that you hold the hearing at a time convenient to the general public and that you give at least 30 days notice to local newspapers and groups regarding the date of the hearing.
