Hi Susan,

The pollutant-specific emission rates shown in Table 6-6 are for both CTs together. These rates are directly linked to hourly emission rates in Tables 2-1 and 2-2 and then multiplied by 2. Rates shown in parenthesis are in lb/hr. The top-half of Table 6-6 is for natural gas-firing cases, so linked to Table 2-1. The bottom-half is for oil-firing cases, linked to Table 2-2.
