Dear Jac,

Thank you for your correspondence of June 17, 2008 in follow-up to our meeting June 4th and discussions thereto. On the attached pages are responses to the items in your letter and Appendix A, which includes vendor data and research materials cited, and Appendix B, which is the Boiler MACT analysis.

Note that the supplemental fuel specifications were revised resulting in lower emission levels. However, the issue of what fuels are commercially available remains for bio fuels versus traditional fuels. Also note the discussion on 40 CFR 60 Da; Yellow Pine does not meet the threshold limits of that rule. This question is a pivotal matter, which we wish to resolve as it has wide-ranging ramifications.

Lastly, please note our concerns regarding timing to compete this permit. Your forecasted date to achieve a draft air permit in November 2008 conflicts with our electricity supply contracts and we would sincerely appreciate your efforts to expedite this work. Once you have had the opportunity to review this material, we would like to schedule a follow-up meeting. Thank you for your consideration.
