Dear Mr. Capp:

I am writing on behalf of Power4Georgians, LLC ("P4G"). In accordance with a Settlement Agreement among Fall-Line Alliance for a Clean Environment, Ogeechee Riverkeeper, Sierra Club, Southern Alliance for Clean Energy (collectively, "Petitioners") and P4G, I am writing to request a modification to the above-reference permit (the "Permit"). Specifically, P4G requests that the Environmental Protection Division ("EPD") add a condition to the Permit that provides "Plant Washington will comply with 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart UUUUU upon start up."¹

In the Settlement Agreement, P4G agreed to request that EPD provide public notice and an opportunity for comment on the draft permit amendment for a period of thirty days. We understand that EPD does not believe that it is required to provide public notice and an opportunity for comment on the draft permit amendment requested in this letter, but P4G appreciates the Division's willingness to help facilitate the resolution of the matters addressed in the Settlement Agreement, including the affirmance of Plant Washington's PSD permit, by favorably considering this request. In addition to publishing the notice in a local newspaper, please consider taking whatever other public

notice actions, such as posting the information on the Air Branch website, which you would typically do.

To resolve all of the Plant Washington matters on appeal at the Office of State Administrative Hearings as quickly as possible, it is important that the public notice appear in the local paper in Washington County as soon as possible, so that the requested thirty-day public comment period can begin to run. For your information, P4G understands that, if the public notice information reaches the paper before the close of business on Friday, April 13, the notice can appear in next week's edition of the paper. P4G is prepared to help get the public notice to the paper for publication. Please let us know if EPD would like our assistance.

Please convey P4G's thanks to your staff for their and your prompt consideration of P4G's requests. Should you have any questions concerning the requested permit modification or P4G's offer to help with the publication of the public notice in the paper, please do not hesitate to contact Dean Alford, Les Oakes or me.
