
The Environmental Protection Division has completed its review of your application for an air quality permit amendment in order to operate a coal-fired power plant facility located in Sandersville, Georgia (Washington County) and has prepared the attached draft air quality Permit amendment. You will have the opportunity to provide comments on this draft Permit prior to the expiration of the public comment period indicated below.

The Public Notice, to be published by Plant Washington, is attached. Within fourteen days after receipt of this letter, the attached Public Notice shall be published once in The Sandersville Progress, P. O. Box 431, 118 East Haynes Street, Sandersville, GA 31082 (Tel: 478-552-3161). You should notify Lynn Rhodes of our office at lynn.rhodes@dnr.state.ga.us at least 7 days prior to publication and inform her of the date on which the Public Notice will be published. A tear sheet of the Public Notice, showing the date of publication, or affidavit of publication must be submitted to my attention within 7 days following the date of publication. The "tear sheet" is the actual page from the newspaper in which the Public Notice is published.

The draft Air Quality Permit and associated documents will be placed on our web site 30 days from the date of this letter or shortly after you notify us of the date of publication of the Public Notice, whichever is sooner.
