BACKGROUND

On April 7, 2016, Jordan Forest Products (hereafter “facility”) submitted a Title V permit amendment and PSD application (No. TV-40991) to increase production through all lumber kilns to 225 million board feet per year (MMbf/yr). The facility is located at 752 Grove Street in Barnesville, Lamar County. Title V Permit Amendment No. 2421-171-0005-V-04-1 authorized the construction and operation of a continuous kiln (ID No. 500D) and imposed a throughput limit of 90 MMbf/yr on Kiln 500D and a throughput limit of 42 MMbf/yr on the existing kilns (ID Nos. 500A, 500B, and 500C) to avoid a PSD review for the addition of Kiln 500D. The facility submitted Application TV-40991 on April 7, 2016 to replace the above PSD avoidance limits with a facility-wide throughput limit of 225 MMbf/yr. No equipment is being modified; however, the relaxation of the PSD avoidance limits triggers a retro-active PSD review.

On June 8, 2016, the Division issued a Preliminary Determination stating that the modifications described in Application No. TV-40991 should be approved. The Preliminary Determination contained a draft Air Quality Permit for the construction and operation of the modified equipment.

The Division requested that Jordan Forest Products place a public notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the area of the existing facility notifying the public of the proposed construction and providing the opportunity for written public comment. Such public notice was placed in *The Herald Gazette* (legal organ for Lamar County) on June 21, 2016. The public comment period expired on July 21, 2016.

During the comment period, there were no comments received from the U.S. EPA Region IV, the facility, or the general public.

Since there is no comment, the draft Title V permit amendment/PSD permit is being issued as the final Title V permit amendment/PSD permit. A copy of the final permit is included in Appendix A.
