Description and Location of Proposed Activity: <u>The proposed project would impact Perennial Stream (PS) 5</u> and Intermittent Stream (IS) 6 for the bridge construction over Battlefield Creek along US Highway 221/State Route 171 in Johnson County. The project would impact 3,404 square feet/ 102 linear feet of the 25-foot state mandated buffer within the Ohoopee River watershed. Disturbance activities will consist of the placement of fill for roadside slopes on the permanent alignment and clearing for contractor access and placement of orange barrier fence (OBF) and other erosion and sedimentation control measures.
