Description and Location of Proposed Activity: <u>The proposed project would impact Intermittent Stream (IS) 5</u> for the bridge construction over Pughes Creek along State Route 29 in Laurens County. The project would impact 14,559 square feet/ 314 linear feet of the 25-foot state mandated buffer within the Lower Oconee Watershed. Disturbance activities will consist of earthwork for roadside slopes, construction access, realignment, and the installation of Best Management Practices (BMPs) erosion and sedimentation control measures such as OBF.
