

MEAG POWER is involved in the expansion of nuclear Plant Vogtle with the operation of new Units 3 and 4 planned for 2017 and 2018, respectively.


MEAG POWER'S MISSION is to generate and transmit reliable and competitive wholesale electric power to our 49 Participant communities.

2005 Energy (MWH) Deliveries




2005 - 50% Emissions Free



2012 Energy (MWH) Deliveries




2012 - 54% Emissions Free
