The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) announces its intent to issue a New Groundwater Withdrawal Permit No. 038-0007 for water withdrawal of 0.504 MGD/ 0.504 MGD (Monthly Average/Annual Average in million gallons per day) from one well(s) in the Crystalline Rock aquifer for the purpose of a central water supply.
