**Notice of Draft Groundwater Withdrawal Permit –
Chatham Water Utility, LLC - Briarcrest / Palmer Place – December 20, 2024**

The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) announces its intent to issue a New Groundwater Withdrawal Permit No. 091-0007 for water withdrawal of 0.165 MGD/ 0.150 MGD (Monthly Average/Annual Average in million gallons per day) from four well(s) in the Floridan aquifer for the purpose of a central water supply.
