Notice of Public Meetings about draft Water Quality Trading Guidance

This notice is to announce that the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) Watershed Protection Branch will be holding four virtual meetings to discuss a draft water quality trading guidance document. This document provides a framework for the implementation of Georgia's water quality trading program. A virtual format was chosen to allow for interested parties across the state to participate. Each meeting will focus on a specific section of the guidance document to ensure sufficient time for discussion. The goal of these four virtual meetings is to provide National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permittees, the agriculture community, mitigation bankers, land trusts, the public, and other stakeholders an opportunity to provide input on the draft guidance document. The draft guidance document was developed based on USDA and USEPA water quality trading guidance documents and memos, as well as feedback received in three stakeholder workshops held by EPD in October 2019. This meeting will serve as the initial kick-off meeting and will include a summary of trading-related projects and the 2019 stakeholder process. The meeting will also include a targeted discussion of sections 1-5 of the draft document, which hold much of the framework for water quality trading.
