is hereby amended as follows: To update the maximum operating time of the VCU to 34 percent of the loading rack operating time with a 99 percent average destruction and removal efficiency (DRE).

New Conditions

2. Allowable Emissions

2.12 The vapor combustion unit VCU shall be operated such that VOC emissions from truck loading do not exceed 11.5 milligrams of total organic compounds per liter of gasoline or ethanol loaded and the destruction and removal efficiency (DRE) of the VCU shall be maintained at no less than 99 percent.

6. Performance Testing

6.6 Within 180 days of the issuance of this permit, the Permittee shall conduct a volatile organic compound destruction efficiency performance test on the VCU to determine compliance with the limits in Condition 2.12.
