Dear Ms. Adcock:

Enclosed is the FINAL Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) Permit No. 4911-263-0013-V-07-1 for Talbot Energy Facility located at 9125 Cartledge Road (Talbot County) for the modification of turbines T1 through T4 to add the capability to burn fuel oil and add water injection and the construction of two fuel oil storage tanks and one emergency fire pump engine. The Georgia Environmental Protection Division – Air Protection Branch has completed its review of this application.

The PSD Preliminary Determination that the proposed change at said facility should be approved was issued on February 12, 2024. The public notice concerning the application and preliminary determination appeared in the *Talbotton New Era* (legal organ for Talbot County) on February 22, 2024. The 30-day public comment period expired on March 25, 2024. No comments were received from the facility. Comments were received from U.S. EPA. No negative comments were received from the general public.

It is the Final Determination that the change at Talbot Energy Facility should be approved. Enclosed is Air Quality Permit Amendment No. 4911-263-0013-V-07-1 and a copy of the Final Determination. This Permit Amendment is for the modifications listed in Application No. 767450. It is not transferable nor is it valid if the originally approved process or facility is changed or modified. A new application for an Air Quality Permit must be submitted for future modification or new construction, which may affect potential emissions from your facility.
