Conditions of Approval Agriculture Waiver for Scrap Tire Storage Limit

The undersigned hereby requests a waiver from the Georgia Environmental Protection Division for storage and use of more than 100 scrap tires for agricultural purposes as provided for in the Georgia Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Act (O.C.G.A.12-8-40.1) and the Rules for Solid Waste Management (391-3-4-.17).

Conditions:

- 1. Scrap tires shall not be stored within 25 feet of an open flame.
- 2. Scrap tires shall be kept stored away from gasoline, diesel fuel, motor oil, and other accelerants.
- 3. Scrap tires shall be stored in accordance with the Scrap Tire Storage Best Management Practices and the Solid Waste Management Rules, Chapter 391-3-1-.19(6).
- 4. Use of the scrap tires is restricted to the farm property listed on the waiver request form.
- 5. The total number of scrap tires to be stored and used is limited to the quantity indicated in the waiver request. If additional tires are needed, an additional waiver request form must be filed with EPD before they are brought to the property.
- 6. The scrap tires must be used in the manner and for the purpose(s) described on the waiver request form.
- 7. If at some point in the future the scrap tires are no longer needed, they must be properly disposed at an EPD permitted or approved scrap tire processing facility.
- 8. The owner of the farm shall be able to obtain scrap tires from scrap tire generators and shall retain copies of manifests from the sources where scrap tires were obtained at the farm for at least three years and make them available for EPD to review upon request.
