Dear Mrs. Yardum and Mr. Yardum:

In a letter dated May 3, 2010, the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) required removal of wood waste from your property to resolve violations associated with the Rules for Comprehensive Solid Waste Management and submittal of a revised Voluntary Remediation Program application, conceptual site model, and preliminary investigation and remediation plan by no later than June 29, 2010. As of this date, EPD has not received the revised application, conceptual site model, and plan. Furthermore, EPD has issued you a September 10, 2010 notice of violation for failure to remove the wood waste on your property.

Therefore, based on the above information and a discussion with your attorney, who indicated you would not be submitting the revised application, conceptual site model, and plan, you are no longer being considered an applicant pursuant to the Voluntary Remediation Program Act.
