The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has received the January 2013 Voluntary Remediation Program (VRP) application that has been submitted pursuant to the Georgia Voluntary Remediation Program Act (the Act) O.C.G.A. 12-8-100. EPD acknowledges that this VRP application was submitted in lieu of a Corrective Action Plan (CAP) Addendum and Revised Compliance Status Report required pursuant to the Georgia Rules for Hazardous Site Response (the Rules) for the above referenced property. EPD is approving your VRP application, which specifies corrective action consisting of the following:

- Conduct a storm drain assessment and implement any necessary repairs in order to prevent groundwater from entering the storm drain system.
- Continued groundwater monitoring and surface water monitoring activities on a semiannual basis.
- Institutional controls on affected properties through the placement of Unified Environmental Covenants.

Therefore, EPD is accepting General Chemical Corporation (GC) as a participant as defined in the Act for the following qualifying property provided Avery implements the VRP application in compliance with the following schedule and conditions:

Within six months of detecting regulated substance(s) on a non-qualifying property, the participant must apply to EPD to include the affected property as a qualifying property under the Act or notify EPD that the non-qualifying property is not included under the Act.

Because GC is performing corrective action at the qualifying property in accordance with an approved VRP corrective action plan, EPD is hereby reclassifying it from Class II to Class V and designating it as needing corrective action as provided for in §12-8-107(b) of the Act.

Within 45 days of this letter, you are required to file an affidavit stating that your property has been listed on the state's hazardous site inventory and has been designated as needing corrective action due to the presence of hazardous wastes, hazardous constituents, or hazardous substances regulated under state law. This affidavit is to be filed with the clerk of the Superior Court of Fulton County and recorded in the clerk's deed records pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 44-2-20.

GC must also place the following notice in any deed, mortgage, deed to secure debt, lease, rental agreement or other instrument given or caused to be given by the property owner which creates an interest in or grants a use of the property:

"This property has been listed on the state's hazardous site inventory and has been designated as needing corrective action due to the presence of hazardous wastes, hazardous constituents, or hazardous substances regulated under state law. Contact the property owner or the Georgia Environmental Protection Division for further information concerning this property. This notice is provided in compliance with the Georgia Hazardous Site Response Act and the Voluntary Remediation Program Act."
