The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has received the February 2013 *Voluntary Remediation Program Status Report No. 2* (February 2013 Report), that has been submitted pursuant to the Georgia Voluntary Remediation Program Act (the Act) O.C.G.A. 12-8-100, by AMEC on behalf of Scott Technologies, Inc. (STI). After completing its review of the referenced document, EPD has provided the following comments:

- 1) The additional data provided within the February 2013 Report has adequately addressed EPD's December 27, 2012, Voluntary Remediation Progress Report No. 1 comments.
- 2) According to the February 2013 Report (Appendix A), approximately 2-feet of yellow, oily liquid was identified in the bottom of monitoring well MW-10. Please include a groundwater and waste characterization analysis for this monitoring well during the next scheduled monitoring event.

Please note that EPD will defer any further comments for the site until the completion of the 5-year Voluntary Remediation Program monitoring period, or until such time that EPD's receipt of additional Progress Reports and associated data may necessitate additional data requirements for the site. EPD has placed the February 2013 Progress Reports in the HSI #10268 facility file for public review.
