The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has received the August 14, 2013 *Voluntary Remediation Program Status Report No. 3* (August 2013 Report), that has been submitted pursuant to the Georgia Voluntary Remediation Program Act (the Act) O.C.G.A. 12-8-100, by AMEC on behalf of Scott Technologies, Inc. (STI). After completing its review of the referenced document, EPD has provided the following comments:

1) According to the August 2013 Report, non-aqueous phase liquid was identified in monitoring well MW-10 during the June 2013 sampling event. A sample was collected and analyzed for volatile organic compounds (VOCs) using USEPA method 8260B. The August 2013 Report indicated that the presence of the oily substance in MW-10 would continue to be evaluated. Please ensure that this continued evaluation includes a comprehensive groundwater and waste characterization analysis, excluding the already completed VOC analysis, for this monitoring well during the next scheduled monitoring event.
