The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has received the August 19, 2014, *Voluntary Remediation Program Status Report No. 5* (August 2014 Report), that has been submitted pursuant to the Georgia Voluntary Remediation Program Act (the Act) O.C.G.A. 12-8-100, by AMEC on behalf of Scott Technologies, Inc. (STI). After completing its review of the referenced document, EPD has provided the following comment:

- According to the August 2014 Report, should the next sampling event indicate that adjacent properties are not at risk, a Uniform Environmental Covenant (UEC) will be executed for the subject site. EPD concurs with the use of institutional controls in form of a UEC as part of the planned VRP corrective measures for the site. However, please note that a sufficient amount of data does not currently exist to rule out the possibility of current or future impacts to the groundwater beyond the property boundary, in particular directly to the east of the MW-19 area. Therefore, EPD recommends that a UEC for the 184 East Meadow Lake Parkway parcel be included in future institutional control plans for the site, unless additional groundwater data can be provided to clearly demonstrate the containment of the groundwater plume within the confines of the site.
