Description and Location of Proposed Activity: <u>The proposed project will impact the buffer of Ditch E (flows into Little Hog Creek)</u>. The project will add two passing lanes for 2.7 miles of State Route 32 between Roberts Cemetery Road in Coffee County and Cody Road in Bacon County. The project will impact the state mandated 25-ft buffer within the Satilla (HUC 03070201) Watershed. The disturbance will cover 13,556 square feet and include placement of roadway slopes, ditch relocation, fill, and the installation of Best Management Practices (BMPs).
