Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

Applicant proposes to impact 199.83 linear feet (5,227.20 ft<sup>2</sup>) of stream buffer along the Etowah River. Impacts are for streambank stabilization with riprap and joint plantings. A 25'x 20' recreational viewing deck will be constructed in the stream buffer on two 4 x 4 footings and will be suspended in the air 10-12 ft. Additionally, a 5 ft wide concrete boat ramp will access the Etowah River. Bioengineered practices include live stakes, rip-rap joint planting, and pervious pavers. The project is located at 87 River Brook Circle in the City of Euharlee in the Etowah Watershed (03150104).
