Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

Stormwater runoff has caused severe streambank erosion along the Little Tallapoosa River near an existing pedestrian trail and bridge along Lovvorn Road in Carrollton. The proposed project will consist of grading the streambank to a more stable slope (1.5H:1V – 2H:1V) and integrated bio-engineering practices (including riprap toe protection and joint plantings with *Silky Dogwood*, *Swamp Dogwood* and *Buttonbush*). The proposed streambank stabilization project will result in approximately 90 linear feet total (3,290 square feet total) of buffer disturbances along the Little Tallapossa River in the *Upper Tallapoosa Watershed*.
