Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

This project will result in the construction and repair of existing infrastructure currently located within the buffer to include shoreline stabilization in areas currently being impacted by the public. The project elements in the buffer include concrete wall extensions, sidewalks and infrastructure to prevent shoreline erosion, treat stormwater runoff, and promote more stable public access. The proposed project will stabilize 1,037 total linear feet shoreline resulting in 23,121 total square feet of buffer disturbance along Lake Carroll an impoundment of Curtis Creek in the Upper Tallapoosa Watershed (03150108).
