Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

Applicant proposes to impact 2,245 linear feet (32,721 ft²) of stream buffer in seventeen separate areas along three unnamed tributaries to Indian Creek. These impacts are a result of the 2011 U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Consent Decree to assess and rehabilitate the existing sanitary sewer system. The sewer lines will be upgraded from 10" to 16" pipe. Upon completion of land-disturbance, the buffer will be returned to pre-existing conditions as much as practicable. This component of the overall project is 0.72 miles long and begins at the intersection of North Decatur Rd. and Reed St./McHenry Ave.
