EPD has received your request to revise the buffer variance authorization for the subject project. The revision requested is to correct a scrivener's error pertaining to the Property Owner's name. This revision to a previously approved buffer variance will not affect the project's original concept, does not change the amount of buffer encroachments and is only a revision of the Property Owner's name as identified in the application.
