Activity

This notice is issued to inform the public of a receipt of an application for a variance submitted pursuant to a state environmental Law. The public is invited to comment during the 30-day period on the proposed activity. Site plans are available for review and are located in the following EPD office: Watershed Protection Branch File Room, 2 MLK Jr. Drive, SW, West Tower, Balcony, Suite 418, Atlanta, GA 30334. Please contact GORArequest.Water@dnr.ga.gov to schedule an appointment to review the plans. Since the EPD has no authority to zone property or determine land use, only those comments addressing environmental issues related to air, water, and land protection will be considered in the application review process. Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. § 12-7-1 et seq.

Applicable Rules: Erosion and Sedimentation Control Chapter 391-3-7

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7.05 (2)(a-k)}: (a) & (h)

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

The proposed project will impact the buffer of IS 102 (unnamed tributary to Cheatam Creek), IS 103 (unnamed tributary to Cheatam Creek), IS 108 (unnamed tributary to Cheatam Creek), PS 112 (unnamed tributary to Cheatam Creek), IS 120 (unnamed tributary to Cheatam Creek). The project will widen and improve an 18.5-mile section of SR 20 between Scott Road in Cherokee County and North Corners Parkway in Forsyth County. The project will impact the state mandated 25-ft buffer within the Etowah [HUC 03150104] and Upper Chattahoochee [HUC 03130001] Watersheds. The disturbance will cover 7,100 square feet and include clearing and discharge of fill within the required ROW, driveway construction and slope grading, culvert replacement, placement of a riprap apron, channel relocation, and the installation of Best Management Practices (BMPs).

Summary of Rules Requirements for Variance Application:

The application for a variance must include an Erosion and Sediment Control Plan with control measures based on sound conservation and engineering practices which meet or exceed the standards in the "Manual for Erosion and Sediment Control in Georgia" and which will minimize erosion and deposition of sediments on adjacent lands or into State waters.
