Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

This project will consist of extending the sewer main (approximately 2,905 lf of 8" Ø DIP and 10" Ø DIP sanitary sewer lines and associated manholes) from the proposed single-family residential development located along the Lydia Lane and Camden Court to an existing manhole located along Timber Ridge in the City of South Fulton. All disturbed areas will be returned to original grade and stabilized with mulching and permanent vegetation and all open-cut trenches will be backfilled and restored to current conditions to the extent practicable. Construction activities will result in approximately 273 linear feet total (5,935 square feet total) of buffer disturbances along unnamed intermittent stream, a tributary to Camp Creek in the *Middle Chattahoochee – Lake Harding Watershed*.
