Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

Beaver Ruin Wetland Park includes an unnamed tributary to Bromolow Creek and 84.3 acres of forested, scrubshrub and emergent wetlands located along Satellite Boulevard in Gwinnett County. The proposed stream and wetland restoration and enhancement project will consist of stabilizing and restoring the stream channel (i.e., installing log and j-hook vanes and constructed riffles, constructing large wood habitat features, grading the streambanks to a more stable slope and live staking and permanent seeding), invasive species management and forested wetland and scrub-shrub wetland supplemental plantings. The proposed project will result in approximately 8,118 linear feet total (253,696 square feet total) of buffer impacts along an unnamed tributary to Bromolow Creek in the *Upper Ocmulgee Watershed*.
