This notice is issued to inform the public of a receipt of an application for a variance submitted pursuant to a state environmental Law. The public is invited to comment during the 30-day period on the proposed activity. Since the EPD has no authority to zone property or determine land use, only those comments addressing environmental issues related to air, water, and land protection will be considered in the application review process. Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. 12-7-1 et seq.

Applicable Rules: Erosion and Sedimentation Control Chapter 391-3-7

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7-.05 (2)(a-k)}: (a)

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

Severe and continuing streambank erosion along Toccoa Creek on the Toccoa Fall College campus has compromised both Forrest Drive and Hansen Road. The proposed streambank stabilization project will consist of realigning Toccoa Creek (i.e., installing a boulder vane, boulder revetments and toe riprap), grading the eroding streambank to a more stable slope and planting live stake and transplant species (such *as Silky Willow, Silky Dogwood, Black Willow, Elderberry, River Birch, Serviceberry, Buttonbush, Tag Alder* and *Sycamore*) with native riparian seed mix, installing curbs and gutters along Forrest Drive and Hansen Road, and installing a *Verti-Block* retaining wall system (or an equivalent retaining wall system) along Forrest Drive. This project will result in approximately 330 linear feet total (10,500 square feet total) of buffer impacts along Toccoa Creek in Stephens County in the *Tugaloo Watershed*.

Summary of Rules Requirements for Variance Application:

The application for a variance must include an approved Erosion and Sediment Control Plan with control measures based on sound conservation and engineering practices which meet or exceed the standards in the "Manual for Erosion and Sediment Control in Georgia" and which will minimize erosion and deposition of sediments on adjacent lands or into State waters.
