This notice is issued to inform the public of a receipt of an application for a variance submitted pursuant to a state environmental Law. The public is invited to comment during the 30-day period on the proposed activity. Since the EPD has no authority to zone property or determine land use, only those comments addressing environmental issues related to air, water, and land protection will be considered in the application review process. Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot State waters buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. § 12-7-1 et seq.

Applicable Rules: Erosion and Sedimentation Control Chapter 391-3-7

Basis under which variance shall be considered {391-3-7.05 (2)(a-k)}: (k2), (h)

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

The proposed project will impact the buffer of Perennial Stream 4a and Intermittent Stream 4d (Unnamed tributaries to Cold Creek). The project will construct a bypass east of the cities of Tennille and Sandersville and individual bridges over two active railroad lines and a third 265 foot long, 77 foot wide bridge over Williamson Swamp Creek/Sun Hill Creek. The project will impact the state mandated 25-ft buffer within the Ohoopee River Watershed (03070107). The disturbance will cover 6,758 square feet (210 linear feet) and include clearing and grubbing within the buffer to only that necessary for construction access and installation of stormwater best management practices.

The application for a variance must include an Erosion and Sediment Control Plan with control measures based on sound conservation and engineering practices which meet or exceed the standards in the "Manual for Erosion and Sediment Control in Georgia" and which will minimize erosion and deposition of sediments on adjacent lands or into State waters.
