Submittal of the Seventh Semi-Annual Progress Report

to the VRP Program for HSI Site No. 10731 BWAY Corporation - Homerville, Georgia

Dear Carolyn:

This letter is being submitted on behalf of BWAY Corporation (BWAY) for the referenced property (Site). It is intended to serve as the Seventh Semi-Annual Progress Report for this Site since it entered the Voluntary Remediation Program (VRP). The Site was accepted into the Voluntary Remediation Program by way of correspondence from the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) dated July 22, 2011.

The last semi-annual report was submitted on July 22, 2014 and indicated BWAY's intention to request a meeting with EPD to formulate a clear and concise path forward for this site to achieve closure under the VRP. The meeting was held on August 28, 2014 and was attended by you and Mr. David Reuland of EPD, Mr. Bruce Bultman of Cornerstone (on behalf of BWAY), and Ms. Amy Hickman and Mr. Jeff Bilkert of ERM. EPD issued a memo on October 14, 2014 summarizing the conclusions of the meeting and additional actions required at the site to achieve closure. In summary, these actions include:

- Installation of a deep-screened monitoring well in the northeastern corner of the site to achieve vertical delineation of groundwater contamination.
- Continuation of established groundwater monitoring events and reporting until submittal of the final CSR for the Site.

- Establish plume stability or shrinkage through contaminant trend analysis and contaminant plume maps over time.
- Submit a draft environmental covenant for EPD review and an Operations & Maintenance (O&M) Plan for continued monitoring of groundwater after site delisting prior to submittal of the final CSR.

ERM and BWAY are in the process of coordinating installation of the deep well for vertical delineation and performing trend analysis of groundwater concentrations. Additional groundwater monitoring has not been conducted during this reporting period as ERM and BWAY believe sufficient monitoring well data are currently available to conduct trend analyses for the Site and demonstrate horizontal delineation. Once the deep well has been installed it will be sampled a minimum of two times to demonstrate vertical delineation.

The professional geologist certification for this progress report submittal and a summary of hours spent by the professional geologist in the last six months are included as Attachments A and B, respectively. Please contact us with any questions or comments you may have.
