This notice is issued to inform the public of a receipt of an application for a variance submitted pursuant to a state environmental Law. The public is invited to comment during the 30-day period on the proposed activity. Since the EPD has no authority to zone property or determine land use, only those comments addressing environmental issues related to air, water, and land protection will be considered in the application review process. Type of Permit Application: Variance to encroach within the 25-foot Coastal Marshlands buffer.

Applicable Law: Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Act O.C.G.A. § 12-7-6 et seq.

Applicable Rules: Erosion and Sedimentation Control Chapter 391-3-7

Basis under which variance shall be considered  $\{391-3-7-.11(2)(a-k)\}$ : (a)

Description and Location of Proposed Activity:

The proposed project involves the installation of 212 linear feet of wooden bulkhead placed landward of the Coastal Marshland Protection Act jurisdictional determination. Disturbance of the buffer is necessary in order to stabilize the erosion of a residential property and provide protection to existing vegetation. No additional impervious surfaces will be constructed within 25 feet of the proposed bulkhead. The buffer disturbance area will be revegetated with native, multi-trophic vegetation upon project completion. The proposed project will result in 202 total linear feet (3,034 total square feet) of coastal marshland buffer disturbance. The project is located off of W 31st Street in the Altamaha Watershed (03070106).

Summary of Rules Requirements for Variance Application:

The application for a variance must include an Erosion and Sediment Control Plan with control measures based on sound conservation and engineering practices which meet or exceed the standards in the "Manual for Erosion and Sediment Control in Georgia" and which will minimize erosion and deposition of sediments on adjacent lands or into State waters.
