The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has received the July 25, 2016, Voluntary Remediation Program 5th Annual Progress Report (2016 Progress Report), which has been submitted by ERM on behalf of Dickies Industrial Services, Inc. pursuant to the Georgia Voluntary Remediation Program Act (the Act) O.C.G.A. 12-8-100. Based on EPD's review of this document, EPD agrees that the contamination will not likely impact the unnamed creek above in-stream water quality standards as stated in the report. The 5-year groundwater monitoring required by the Uniform Environmental Covenant has been completed and no further groundwater monitoring is required at this time.

In addition, EPD is also approving the 2016 Annual Property Evaluation and certification of compliance dated June 7, 2016. The annual site inspection report and certification must continue to be submitted to fulfill the requirements of the Georgia Environmental Covenants Act, O.C.G.A. 44-16-1 et seq.
