
Dear Mr. Simpson:

The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) is in receipt of the Voluntary Remediation Plan Addendum dated November 16, 2017, for the above referenced property (the Property) pursuant to the Georgia Voluntary Remediation Program Act (the Act). Subsequent to our review of these documents, EPD offers the following comments.

1. EPD acknowledges and appreciates the response to EPD's comments in the letter dated September 20, 2017. In regards to comment #1 of the letter, please include sub-slab soil gas testing along with the proposed air monitoring program following the future shutdown of the SVE system. The other comments have been addressed to EPD's satisfaction within the Remediation Plan Addendum.
2. EPD has reviewed the Risk Reduction Standards (RRS) submitted for metals in groundwater and approves the proposed Type 2 and Type 4 RRS for Barium and Manganese. It should be noted that the Type 1 groundwater RRS for Barium as presented in the table is incorrect due to a conversion error from mg/L to µg/L. The groundwater criterion presented in Appendix III, Table 1 of the Georgia Rules for Hazardous Site Response is 2 mg/L, which is equal to 2,000 µg/L and not 200 µg/L. Please revise the table accordingly in subsequent reporting.
