The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has reviewed the February 2016 Voluntary Remediation Program (VRP) Compliance Status Report (CSR), submitted to EPD by Hillshire Brands Company and Rathon Corporation pursuant to the Georgia Voluntary Remediation Program Act (the Act), O.C.G.A. 12-8-100. Based upon EPD's review of this document and information in its files, EPD concurs that the property, Diversey-Olympic Manufacturing (Former), has been fully delineated and corrective action will be complete for Tax Parcels 7096200070, 17096200140, 17096200150, and 7096200220, in accordance with Type 1 risk reductions standards for soil and Type 5 risk reduction standards for groundwater, as documented in the VRP CSR, upon execution of environmental covenants. Therefore, the VRP CSR is hereby approved.
