The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has determined that filed stamped executed Uniform Environmental Covenant (UEC), received on December 31, 2014, for the above referenced site is complete in accordance with the Georgia Voluntary Remediation Act (the Act) O.C.G.A. 12-8-100.


Furthermore, EPD concurs with your certification of compliance that soil and groundwater at the relevant voluntary remediation property are in compliance with the applicable voluntary remediation cleanup standards established within the December 2013 Updated Compliance Status Report, which requires UECs prohibiting residential use of the site property and restricting the use of groundwater for certain surrounding properties.

Therefore, EPD is reclassifying this site as a Class III site and is removing it from the Hazardous Site Inventory in accordance with §391-3-19-.05(4)(b) of the Rules of Hazardous Site Response (the Rules) and §12-8-107(f) of the Act as of the date of this letter.

As required by §391-3-19-.06(5)(f) of the Rules, a public notice announcing this determination shall be published in *The Brunswick News*.
