The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has reviewed the Voluntary Remediation Program (VRP) Compliance Status Report (CSR) dated June 11, 2018 and the Uniform Environmental Covenants (UECs) recorded June 28, 2018, for the above referenced site. Based on these documents, EPD has determined that the CSR is complete and meets the requirements of the Georgia VRP Act. In a letter dated June 20, 2018, EPD concurred with your certification that this site is in compliance with residential risk reduction standards (RRS) for soil. Because the UECs have been executed and recorded, EPD concurs that groundwater is in compliance with Type 5 RRS with controls in accordance with the provisions, purposes, standards, and policies of the VRP Act. Therefore, I am reclassifying this site as a Class III site, and I am removing it from the Hazardous Site Inventory in accordance with Subparagraph 391-3-19-.05(4)(b) of the Rules for Hazardous Site Response (Rules) and Sections 12-8-107(f) of the Georgia Voluntary Remediation Program Act as of the date of this letter. As required by Subparagraph 391-3-19-.06(5)(f) of the Rules, a public notice announcing this determination shall be published in the *Miller County Liberal*.
