

NOTIFICATION OF COMPLIANCE STATUS

FOR DRYCLEANERS USING PERCHOLOROETHYLENE

40 CFR Part 63 Subpart M
Perchloroethylene Air Emission Standards for Dry Cleaning Facilities

40 CFR Part 63 Subpart M applies to all dry cleaning facilities that use perchloroethylene (PCE). The original regulation was published in the Federal Register on September 22, 1993, amended on July 27, 2006 and September 21, 2006 and adopted by reference in Chapter 391-3-1-.02(9)(b)(27) of the *Georgia Rules for Air Quality Control*. The amended regulation requires all dry cleaning facilities using PCE to submit this Notification of Compliance Status (NOCS) form to the Georgia Environmental Protection Division and to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Region 4 or before **July 28, 2008**. Dry cleaning facilities that begin operations after July 28, 2008 must submit this NOCS form within thirty (30) days of the facility startup date. As defined in the regulation, the term *dry cleaning facility* means an establishment with one or more dry cleaning systems, and a *dry cleaning system* means a dry cleaning machine and its ancillary equipment.
