Re: Draft 2024 305(b)/303(d) List of Waters

Dear Ms. Butler:

The purpose of this correspondence is to transmit to you a copy of Georgia’s draft 2024 305(b)/303(d) List of Waters as required by Section 303(d) of the Federal Clean Water Act. The list was developed in accordance with 40 CFR Part 130.7(b)(4) and guidance provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA). The submittal of the draft 2024 305(b)/303(d) List of Waters to EPA’s ATTAINS database via the Exchange Network has been delayed due to a bug on the ATTAINS side. EPA Headquarters is aware of the situation and it working to fix this issue. Once the bug has been fixed, we will submit our 2024 cycle data to ATTAINS.

As in previous years, the 305(b)/303(d) List of Waters was prepared using all existing and readily available data and information in accordance with U.S. EPA guidance. The following documents are included as part of our draft submittal:

- 2024 Listing Assessment Methodology
- A summary of listing decisions
- Highlights of the 2024 305(b)/303(d) List of Waters
- A list of changes to assessments between the 2022 and 2024 305(b)/303(d) List of Waters
- Key to the abbreviations and codes used in the 305(b)/303(d) List of Waters
- Tables of waters where we have updated IDs, Names, Locations or made changes to the GIS coverages
- Georgia’s draft 2024 305(b)/303(d) List of Waters
- Copy of the public notice for the draft 2024 305(b)/303(d) List of Waters

The draft 2024 305(b)/303(d) List of Waters is being placed on public notice at this time. The public notice also includes information about the development of Georgia’s Prioritization Framework under the “2022 - 2032 Vision for the Clean Water Act Section 303(d) Program” guidelines. GA EPD
