




- Common examples of Modifications that often do not result in changes to or additions of permit conditions.**
- Like-for-like replacement of a control device
 - Replacement of a control device on a system not requiring monitoring or record keeping.
 - Replacement of a control device on a process where monitoring and record keeping parameters on the control device are covered in the permit and would not require modification.

Modification under NSPS

Modification means any physical change in, or change in the method of operation of an existing facility that increases the amount of any air pollutant (to which a standard applies) emitted into the atmosphere by that facility or that results in the emission of any air pollutant (to which a standard applies) into the atmosphere not previously emitted.
