Question	Answer
How often is the cost per passenger tire equivalent (PTE) reimbursement cap reviewed?	The cost per PTE reimbursement cap is reviewed annually.
Can local government applicants haul collected tires to the permitted beneficial reuse processor?	Yes, the local government applicant can haul collected tires to the permitted beneficial reuse processor. This activity does not require for the local government applicant to obtain a carrier permit.
If a local government applicant has a large tire dump on property owned by the applicant, can they apply for a STAR Grant to remove the tires?	Yes, the local government applicant may apply for a STAR tire dump project. Tire dump applications require extra documentation, such as a letter from code enforcement. The tire dump may be located on private or applicant-owned property; however, the local government applicant is responsible for all clean-up activities in order to be reimbursed.
Is there a way to revise applications once submitted?	Yes, contact <a href="mailto:epd.star@dnr.ga.gov">epd.star@dnr.ga.gov</a> and the grant team can unlock the application.
Does the local government need to keep a list of people bringing in tires for an amnesty event?	No, a list of participants is not required.
